Explanation of Responses:

- The securities are held by The Peter C. Brandt 2020-4 GRAT (the "GRAT"). The Reporting Person is the trustee of the GRAT and, as such, has voting and investment power over the shares held by the GRAT.
- The reported transaction involved an amendment of an outstanding warrant, resulting in the deemed cancellation of the "old" warrant and the grant of a "replacement" warrant. The warrant was originally granted on December 13, 2023 and later amended on October 4, 2024 with an exercise price of \$0.45 per share and expiration date of October 4, 2025. On April 27, 2025, the warrant's exercise price was reduced to \$0.1844 per share and the warrant expiration date was amended to May 2, 2025.
- Fully vested and exercisable.
- The reported securities are included within 81,967 units purchased by the Reporting Person on December 13, 2023 for \$1.22 per unit. Each unit consists of one share of common stock, one Series A warrant and one Series B warrant, each warrant represents the right to purchase 81,967 shares of common stock.
- The reported transaction involved an amendment of an outstanding warrant, resulting in the deemed cancellation of the "old" warrant and the grant of a "replacement" warrant. The warrant was originally granted on December 13, 2023 with an exercise price of \$1.50 and expiration date of December 13, 2028. The exercise price was reduced to \$0.1844 per share and the warrant expiration date was amended to May 2, 2025.
